## **RAF** runner wins Cambourne 10K

James Bellward from the RAF won the 8th Cambourne 10K on 10 April with an excellent time of 33 minutes and two seconds. The winning female was Victoria Knight from the Cambridge and Coleridge Athletics Club in 35 minutes and 57 seconds.

Around 1,000 keen runners tackled the multi-terrain course, with 200 children and beginners enjoying the one mile Fun Run - won by Daniel Mitton in 5 minutes and 25 seconds.

The 10K Run is a great fundraising opportunity and, in 2016, the Papworth Trust was chosen as the main beneficiary. This local charity works with disabled and older people throughout Cambridgeshire and across the region.

The Cambridge Cambourne 10K Run and Fun Run are manned entirely by volunteers and organised by an experienced team from Advanced Performance, Cambridge and Coleridge Athletics Club, Cambourne Parish Council and Cambourne Business Park.

## Depression: don't go through it alone

Everyone feels down now and again but when these feelings are persistent or affecting normal life this may be a sign of depression. Sometimes it is those close to us who notice we are not behaving in a way we usually would. Loss of interest in things, changes in appetite or sleep habits and poor concentration can all possibly suggest depression. It is also common to have physical symptoms such as loss of energy, moving more slowly or unexplained aches and pains.

Depression is incredibly common. The causes can be complicated but may be related to difficult life experiences and changes in chemical balances in the brain. Postnatal depression can occur up to a year after the birth of a child and can affect 1 in 10 women. Sadly this is often unreported but it is not in anyway a sign of being a bad mother and help is available through your GP or health visitor.

The things that help depression vary from person to person. Being kind to yourself is a good start. Connecting with other people, physical activity and eating and drinking healthily can all help. Medication may be useful, as may talking therapies both of which your GP can support you with. Depression is not a sign of weakness. Going through it alone makes it much harder and sharing how you feel with those close to you and your GP/ health visitor is definitely a step in the right direction.

## Heidi Allen on schools and upgrading the A428

Since I last wrote, I have visited five primary schools and co-hosted a meeting at Cambourne Village College with the Regional Schools Commissioner. Heads and Governors from secondary schools across Cambridgeshire were invited to share best practice, concerns and generally anything on their minds. Difficulties with teacher recruitment was probably the main topic of conversation and we floated the idea of running a recruitment fair to help schools fill their vacancies. I'll be looking at this over the next few weeks.

From schools to roads, I met with the Secretary of State, Patrick McLoughlin and his special advisor to ensure funds remained in place for the upgrade to the A428. I had heard rumours that the project may be delayed, however I was told that was not the case. It will be a complex and expensive project from an engineering point of view, but I will ensure local residents are kept informed at every step of the way. Highways England are currently identifying possible outline routes and I will share these as soon as I have them. And finally, over the last month I have been trialling a new way of running my surgeries. I held two "no appointment necessary" drop-in events in Sawston and Comberton. The sessions proved really popular with dozens of residents coming along to talk to me on a wide variety of topics. Please see www.heidisouthcambs.co.uk for details of the next scheduled sessions. #### WILDLIFE REVIEW

We have started to monitor the ground nesting birds around Crow Hill in the Country Park again this year, getting out early once a week to look for signs of skylarks, meadow pipits, reed buntings and other birds nesting and feeding young chicks. We have quite a few years' worth of data now that we have started to analyse, to look at where the birds prefer to nest in relation to the short and long mown grass areas and the paths.

Please remember to always keep your dog under control around the green spaces of Camborne, but be particularly aware that at this time of year there will be birds nesting in the long grass and low down in the bushes that could be disturbed by a dog running through. Please keep to the official paths and remember to pick up after your dog where ever you are.
