Mobile Post Office set to roll into Cambourne

CAMBOURNE PARISH COUNCIL has announced that to help restore Post Office services to Cambourne, it is proposed to add the village to the mobile Post Office van service provided by the postmaster for Hemingford Grey.

A mobile service is a specifically designed vehicle that brings Post Office services to communities without relying on fixed premises.

The plan is for the mobile van service to visit the Hub car park every Wednesday from 12.15 – 4.15pm from Wednesday 6 September 2017.

The previous Post Office at Lloyds Pharmacy closed in 2013 due to the resignation of the Postmaster and the withdrawal of the premises for Post Office use. Currently the nearest branches are at Papworth Everard and Elsworth.



Michael Brennan, Post Office Area Network Operations Manager, said: "The addition of Cambourne to the mobile Post Office van service presents the best possible solution to provide Post Office services to this rural village. We hope that customers will make good use of the service."

The Post Office is now inviting customers and interested parties to give their comments on the move in a public consultation which will close on 19

September 2017. Submissions can be made during the consultation by Freepost YOUR COMMENTS to Post Office Ltd, via email to comments@postoffice.co.uk, or via the Customer Helpline on 03457 22 33 44 or Textphone 03457 22 33 55.

Eid al-Fitr translates from Arabic as the "festival of breaking the fast" and involves a range of celebrations as friends, family and the entire Muslim community come together.

After the congregational Eid prayer at the College, traditional sweets including dates, vermicelli and baklava were shared with the congregation, with the kids enjoying special treats.

Eid al-Fitr marks the end of Ramadan, which is a month of fasting that started on Friday 26th May and finished on Saturday June 24.

Every Muslim is required to pay Zakat al-Fitr of £5 per person at the conclusion



of the month of Ramadan as a token of thankfulness to God for having enabled him or her to observe the obligatory fast. Its purpose is to purify those who fast from any shortcomings and to help the poor and needy.

Councillor vacancies

Following the resignations of Simon Crocker and Jeni Sawford no election has been called. The vacancies will therefore be filled by Co-option whereby the existing councillors choose new councillors from the candidates that have come forward.

To qualify as a Parish Councillor, you must be over 18 and a registered elector in the Parish of Cambourne OR have occupied as owner or tenant land in the Parish of Cambourne for the preceding 12 months OR had your principal place of work in the Parish of Cambourne for the preceding 12 months OR have lived in the Parish or within 4.8km of the Parish for the preceding 12 months.

The role of Parish Councillor is an interesting, varied and rewarding one. The position will initially be until May 2018 when all-out local council elections are due to take place.

The co-option will take place at the Council Meeting on 5th September 2017 and anyone wishing to be considered should contact the Parish Clerk for an application form. The deadline is noon on Tuesday 29th August 2017.

Travelling in and out of Cambridge can be difficult so I was interested to hear about the eight options for a new Park & Ride site when I attended a Greater Cambridge Partnership workshop a few weeks ago. A final decision on the location will be made in September.

Some of you might be living in a council home, so following the recent Grenfell tragedy, we can reassure you that all external wall insulation installed by the Council conforms to British Standards and is approved by the British Board of Agreement [BBA]. The systems have fire resistance and are compliant with Building Regulation B4. In May 2017 a company called Safesmart, specialists in fire risk assessment, was commissioned to carry out a full fire safety inspection of our blocks and sheltered housing communal rooms. There will be a full report and the Council will take any action that is recommended.

At the first Cambourne Eid Festival recently we celebrated our community and the rich diversity of human kind that we represent here. I really enjoyed meeting so many of you – and what fabulous weather we had! A few of the children showed me the beautiful posters they made and my partner and I sampled lots of the food, wandered around chatting to people and had a lovely time. U3A stands for the University of the Third Age, which is a self-help, learning co-operative of older people, which enables members to share many educational, creative and leisure activities in a friendly environment. It consists of local U3As all over the UK - charities run by volunteers.

Local U3As draw upon the knowledge, experience and skills of their own members to organise and provide interest groups in accordance with the wishes of the membership in such fields as art, languages, music, history, life sciences, philosophy, computing, crafts, photography and walking.

Activities are organised mainly in small groups that meet regularly, often in each other's homes and members learn from each other. A typical U3A has about 250 members but could be as small as 12 and as large as 2,000.

The U3A approach to learning is – learning for pleasure. There is no accreditation or validation and there are no assessments or qualifications to be gained.

What have I got to be grateful for?



Gratitude may seem a slightly unusual topic in an article on health, but there is an increasing belief that it can have a significant effect on our emotional wellbeing.

The idea of 'counting our blessings' has clearly been around for many years but more recently this has formed the basis of many research studies.

These have shown that practicing gratitude (more than just having an 'attitude of gratitude') can improve wellbeing scores, sleep and stress.

One way to do this is by completing a gratitude journal every day. The research suggests if you note down three things you are grateful for, that within a few weeks you are likely to notice an improvement in your wellbeing.

These should vary everyday and can be small things such as enjoying a coffee or a conversation or the smell of a flower or hearing birds singing.

The techniques of mindfulness or 'taking notice' of your surroundings can be useful in helping identify small but wonderful things.

Another technique can be replacing the phrase "I need to.." with "get to...". Although it does not always work, it does often highlight how much we have.

You may not feel like being grateful but as David Steindl-Rast said "It is not joy that makes us grateful, but gratitude that makes us joyful".



When we stand in the water upright it is as like Christ on the cross. When we are lowered into the water as he was in the tomb covered, but temporary. When we are raised up again, like the victory over the grave. The old life we led died on the cross. The power of sin and the grave



died with Jesus' Resurrection. Baptism does not save, nor is the water special, but it is a command and a privilege. Afterwards we let the children play in the pool.







With an experienced team of Caseworkers and Surveyors we work with clients to help find the right solution to meet their needs.



Disabled Facilities Grants (DFGs)

We will help clients apply for Disabled Facilities Grants (DFGs). These are mandatory grants for disabled people to allow them to carry out essential adaptations to provide better freedom of movement into and around the home and to access essential facilities within it. Some examples of work we can help with are:

- Improving access
- Installing a stair lift
- Providing a suitable bathing facility
- Improving or providing a heating system or adapting heating or lighting controls to make them easier to use

You will be advised to contact Cambridgeshire Direct to request an assessment by an Occupational Therapist, on 03450 455 202. This is to ensure that any adaptations will meet your needs.

Costs and Funding for a DFG

Grants are means tested (except where they are for a disabled child or you are in receipt of a qualifying benefit) so you may be required to make a contribution towards the cost of the work.

How long will this take?

The length of time taken will depend on getting necessary information about the applicant, the nature of the works and whether any additional permissions are needed (from the owner of the property or planning permission, for example). Typically, works should be completed within 4-8 months.

Cambs HIA will charge a fee based on the net cost of any works. If you qualify for a full grant this will form part of your grant amount.

Housing Repairs Grants (HRAs)

Housing Repairs Grants are available in South Cambridgeshire and Cambridge City and are to help maintain, repair and improve your home to ensure that it is safe, comfortable and continues to meet your needs. We can help with things such as new boilers and central heating, damp and mould, and windows and doors.

To be eligible for these types of grant you must own the property, have lived in it for at least 2 years and be in receipt of a qualifying benefit or on a low income.
